Minutes of November 7, 2006 Meeting

The November 2006 meeting was called to order by Steve Peterson, who now realizes it was a mistake to seek the class presidency instead of the ASB presidency, because of the work involved in organizing reunions. (A job I am certain he would compare to herding cats.) In an unusual display of questionable judgment he once again appointed the undersigned as the meeting secretary and scribe. The placing of ads in the Herald was discussed briefly and then delegated to Dave Dorsey to gain information and discuss at the next meeting.

Entertainment: Steve "The Entertainer" Juntala (you must remember BYE,BYE BIRDIE) reported on discussions with EHS Jazz band various options we had depending on the venue of the event. The Future of Flight facility was problematic as the deposit with the hotel was a facility deposit and not a catering deposit. The consideration for budget purposes raised at this point of the meeting was the anticipated attendance at the event and whether the hotel would be adequate for the event. The size of the facility also impacted the entertainment to be utilized. A DJ for the event was also taken into consideration and these options were to be more firm at the January meeting.

Miscellaneous: Merchandising of commemorative shirts would be done through the Blue and Gold group as they have more contacts and this would save us time and money in the long run. Decorations and Nostalgia would be separate committees. Bill "We'll have the

girls do it” Tackitt suggested Suzie Peterson Schmidt and Kathy Stewart Romstad serve as co-chairs of the decorations committee, which they agreed to do after all of the other sensitive males apologized for Tackitt’s sexist remarks.

CRITICAL MEETING: STEVE STATED THAT THE NEXT MEETING IS CRITICAL IN THE PLANNING STAGE BECAUSE WE NEED TO REACH FINAL DECISIONS ON VENUE, BUDGET AND ENTERTAINMENT. THIS IS LARGELY DEPENDENT ON CLASSMATES RESPONSES. BILL REAFFIRMED IT IS IMPORTANT FOR US TO MAKE CONTACT WITH OUR FELLOW CLASSMATES.
